## **Class Lists**

With that, <u>for students who are not impacted by concapping or leveling, class lists are final</u>. Middle school schedules should be visible in Infinite Campus starting August 21st.

## **Student Login and Password**

I recommend that prior to the start of distance learning to insure as seamless a start as possible on September 3rd, you have your students follow this link and select the "Clever" option to check if they know/remember their login and password: <u>https://www.scusd.edu/student-online-tools</u>

All students have a username login that typically looks like this: firstname-lastname@student.scusd.edu. Returning students who do not remember their passwords, and new students who need to establish their password will need to reset their password by visiting <u>https://www.scusd.edu/student-online-tools</u> and clicking on "Account Password Reset."
