This is your principal, Mr. Eder. Your Didion staff has been hard at work preparing for the first day of school on September 2nd. We can't wait to see our students back on campus! Here are some important updates:

Parent Orientation: There will be a <u>virtual Parent Orientation on Wednesday, August 25th, at 5:30pm</u> for parents interested in attending a live Zoom orientation session with Mr. Eder. Our Zoom meeting limit is 300 participants, so only the first 300 attendees will be allowed into the meeting. The presentation information will also be sent out via email and posted to the Didion website. Socially-Distanced Coffee Chat w/Mr. Eder: Mr. Eder will be available on Tuesday, August 24th and Tuesday, August 31st, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. out in front of the school for any parents that would like to introduce themselves, ask questions, or just to briefly visit. If you do plan to visit, please make sure to wear a mask and to maintain 6 feet of distancing between yourself and others.
