# **Health and Safety Reminders**

Thank you, families, for your cooperation and understanding in keeping your student home when they are sick and exhibiting symptoms of illness. Keeping our classrooms and school open, and keeping our students, staff, and families as safe as possible, is truly a full community effort. If your child is ill, please call the main office to be connected with our Health Aides so that they may follow their health protocols that are based on guidance from the California Department of Public Health and Sacramento County Public Health Department to determine when your student may return to school.

Please note that our district and county COVID symptoms and quarantining protocols may differ and be more conservative than what your medical provider may suggest.

Remember, if your child tests positive for COVID-19 or is a close contact of someone who has tested positive, the student must stay home and families must immediately notify the school so we can respond appropriately.

Visit the <u>Reopening Dashboard</u> for more information regarding district and school-site COVID cases and quarantines. In the event of a COVID exposure in a classroom, parents of students in that classroom will be given an advisory notice and close contacts will be contacted directly. <u>Make sure your contact information is up-to-date with the office and that messages from @scusd.edu</u> are not going to your Junk Mail folder.
