Good evening Didion families,

Mr. Eder here with many important updates and announcements. Please check your email for a script of this call.

Remember last spring when we almost sold out Panda Express at Delta Shores? Well, PTA has organized a series of restaurant fundraisers, called "**Dragons Dine Out**," this year to help raise funds for important PTA programs and community events. Our very first fundraiser will be this Thursday, September 30th. And there's no better place to start than Panda Express! If you order food from the Delta Shores Panda Express and show them our school code on the 30th, they will donate 20% to our PTA. Parents, if you are interested in running for a seat on Didion's **School Site Council**, please email Mr. Eder by October 4th. We have positions available to parents, and will hold elections if there is more interest than open positions. The School Site Council typically meets 4-5 times a year, and discusses the development of the School Plan for Student Achievement. The School Site Council also serves as the School Safety Committee.

Every year it is imperative that we have all families submit an **LCFF application** for their child(ren). Only one application is required per household. These applications impact the amount of funding that SCUSD and, ultimately, Didion, receives from the state.
