Report Vaccination Status

The district is asking that all families report the vaccine status of their child(ren) by the end of the day today. Please visit this website to fill out a form for your student: Report Vaccine Status

Surveillance Testing

We have started the mandated COVID-19 surveillance testing program at Didion. All students *who are not fully vaccinated* will be <u>required</u> to participate in regular, weekly testing. At this time, <u>all</u> students who are <u>registered</u> for testing take part in our weekly testing program.

Fully vaccinated students may be opted out of our current weekly testing program by <u>submitting their</u> <u>vaccination record</u> and emailing the office at didionoffice@scusd.edu.

If your child is not fully vaccinated, and if you haven't done so already, please register your child to take part in our weekly testing program in order to be in compliance with the mandate: Register for Weekly COVID Testing

Grade 1-6 Minimum Days, 12/3 - 12/13

Friday, 12/3 through Monday, 12/13 will be minimum days for grades 1-6 due to the end of the first trimester and parent-teacher conferences. From 12/3 - 12/13 students will be dismissed at the following times:

Kindergarten: 11:45 1st - 3rd: 12:05 4th - 6th: 12:19 7th - 8th: 2:29

* Please note that kindergarten, 7th, and 8th grade will be dismissed at their normal times.

Free Nutcracker Performances for Didion Families

The district's partnership with <u>CLARA</u> has resulted in Didion being selected to receive free tickets for the Sacramento Ballet's production of the *Nutcracker*. All 4 of the community shows are available to schools on a "first come, first served" basis. There are approximately 500 tickets available for each performance but once tickets are used up for a performance, it will disappear as an option on the form. STUDENTS AGED 11 OR YOUNGER

SCUSD does not currently require this age group to be vaccinated. All you need to do by Tuesday, November 30th is:

- 1. Submit the student form at <u>scusd.edu/reportvaccine</u>, selecting the "Not Yet Required (age 11 or under)" option.
- 2. Register your student (if not yet fully vaccinated) for COVID-19 testing at scusd.edu/covid-19-testing.

NOTE: You only need to register and consent for COVID-19 testing one time a year. If you have already registered your student there are no further steps required.

STUDENTS AGED 12 OR OLDER

SCUSD requires vaccination. Some exemptions may apply. All you need to do by Tuesday, November 30th is:

- 1. Complete the student form at scusd.edu/reportvaccine and submit your student's vaccination record or valid exemption.
- 2. Register your student (if not yet fully vaccinated) for COVID-19 testing at scusd.edu/covid-19-testing.

NOTE: You only need to register and consent for COVID-19 testing one time a year. If you have already registered your student there are no further steps required.
