

Didion TK 2024-2025 Supply Information

Dear Parents,

Welcome to TK! We will need lots of supplies this year. Here's what you need to know: Each child should bring a backpack daily, something the child can manage and without wheels. In that backpack should be these items only:

1. One 1 or 2-gallon zip-lock baggie with a full change of clean clothes (pants and shirt or dress, underpants, and socks) labeled with the child's name.
2. One water bottled, filled in the morning, labeled with your child's name.
3. **If the child will stay for an after-care program and will be bringing lunch from home, then a lunch pail with lunch items sealed inside.

Please do not send anything else to school for your child's personal use: no pencils, crayons, books, notebooks, toys, jewelry, slap bracelets, candy, treats, etc.

Classroom supplies are handled by parent donations. We will need these items daily:
